Recent Council Activities

Tootsie Roll Drive



This year's drive was on September 15 and 16th. Knights and their families collected and handed-out tootsie rolls in front of Wal-Mart, Al's Supermarkets on Franklin Street & Karwick Road, and East Side Produce & Meats. We will also be collected after all masses on September 10, 2023 at St. Mary's, September 17, 2023 at Queen of All Saints, and September 21, 2023 at St. Stan's. As we handed out a "tootsie roll" and thanked people for their donation, we remembered how fortunate we are, for God's grace, for our blessings in life, and the ability to donate for a good cause of supporting our disabled neighbors in need.

In 2022, we collected \$14,200.00 and donated these funds to organizations directly working and enriching the lives of handicapped people. We donated \$13,350.00 (\$4450.00 to each) to local organizations (listed below) for the mentally and physically handicapped. Only the cost of the Tootsie Rolls and the direct mail campaign was taken from the proceeds we collected. This reflects a 94% return.

Aid and Support After Pregnancy

Aid and Support After Pregnancy (ASAP), describes the Knights of Columbus' efforts to support pregnant women, mothers and their babies by serving pregnancy resource centers and maternity homes.

On October 7th and 8th our Council began a Baby Bottle Drive. As the name suggests, the drive uses baby bottles to collect loose change, cash and checks.

You saw Knights at the doors of the church handing out Baby Bottles for you to take home and fill and bring back on October 28th and 29th. The money collected will be used by local pregnancy centers or maternity homes to purchase supplies to support mothers who choose to have their baby and not to have an abortion.

All of these events could not have been conducted without all of the Knights and their wives. The women of this council work very hard to assist in all of these events and I thank all of them for their dedication and love in helping others. As I noted in the last newsletter, "Everyone who has committed themselves to doing "Good for Others" should be very proud of all of the accomplishments."

As we move closer to the end of the year our work is not done and plans for a new project is on the works. More later. We have continued our membership drives for 2023-2024. We have or will visit every parish in Michigan City providing parishioners with information about becoming a Knight and why joining then Knights of Columbus is so important especially in these troubled times.
