40 Cans for Lent



What is 40 CANS FOR LENT®?

It is a program designed to help fight hunger. An opportunity to take a small sacrifice and turn it into a big difference in the lives of others.

The Program is simple. Collect one can of food per day during the 40 days of Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday, and then one extra can per person on Easter Sunday. Drop off your cans at any time throughout the Season.

As of this publication, calling the 40 Cans for Lent initiative a success would be an understatement! In March, we collected an impressive 2,038 pounds! For comparison, we gathered 361 pounds in January and 586 pounds in February, and Easter is still on the horizon! Additionally, we're eagerly awaiting the total from St. Mary's, and with everyone's support, we could surpass 2 tons!

City-wide Confirmation


